

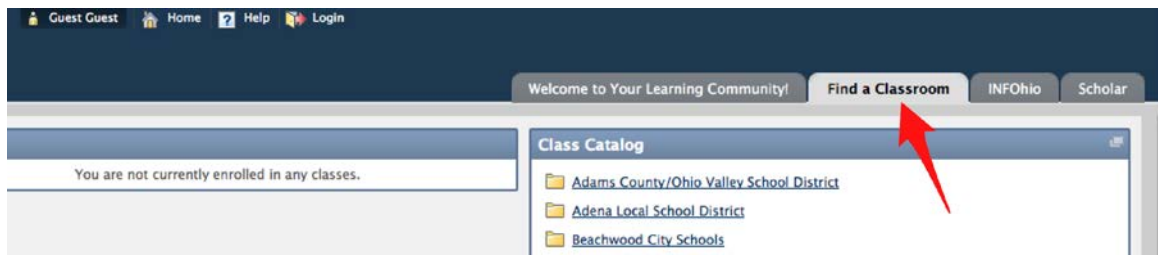
Enroll in “Teen Dating Violence Prevention Education and/or Safety and Violence Prevention Training”

Launch your web browser (Internet Explorer or other web browser)

*Go to <http://scoesc.scoa-k12.org>

1. Click on the tab at top right to “Find a Classroom.”



2. In the “Class Search” box, type in “teen” then click “Go.”



3. When the new page comes up, all the School Categories will be listed. Scroll down (past all the school categories) to the bottom of the screen.

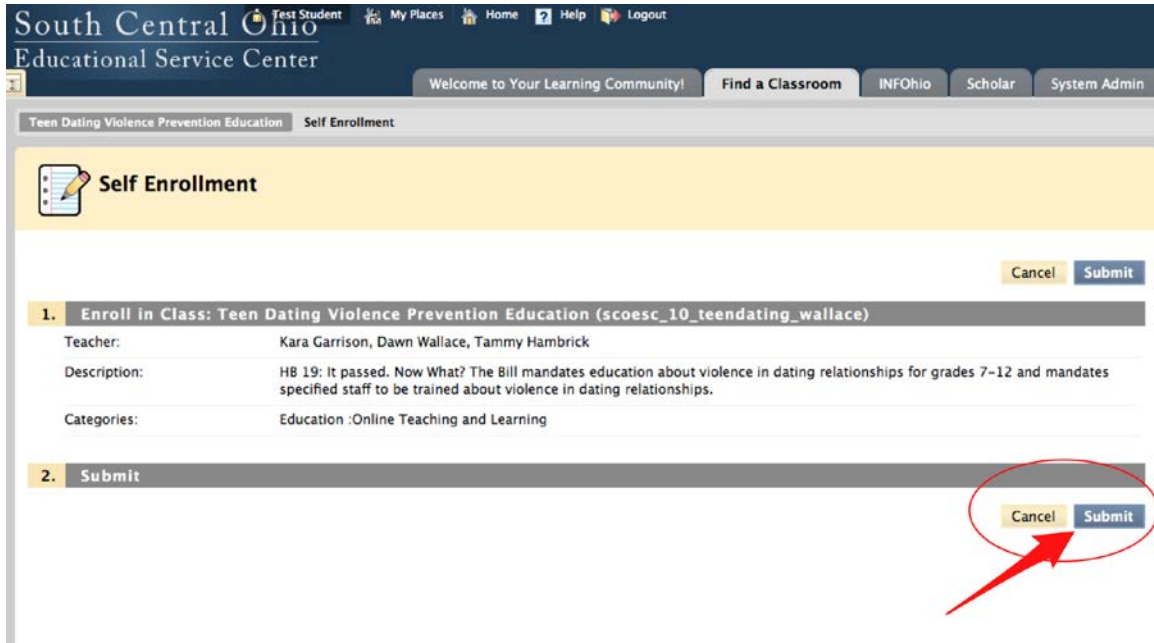
