

Job-Embedded PD and Coaching

South Central Ohio Educational Service Center is committed to providing opportunities for professional development that meet the specific needs of a district based on their individual district, school, and grade level data.

Our primary and preferred approach to professional learning is job-embedded within the school or district. We believe that learning occurs best within the context of real work.

The following are examples of the type of work the SCOESC Curriculum Department provided in 2008-09:

- Districts contracted for year-long training in curriculum alignment to bring into proper relationship three aspects of the curriculum: the written, the taught, and the tested.
- Districts contracted for year-long facilitation in the Ohio Improvement Process.
- Districts contracted for administrative training on teacher evaluations and walk-throughs.
- Districts contracted for teaching training for safety and violence prevention curriculum.
- Districts contracted for specific training in regards to local report card data.
- Districts contracted for professional development that addresses specific reading and math strategies identified as areas of need in the Ohio Improvement Process.
- Districts contracted for curriculum audits.
- Districts contracted for five full day Teacher Academies to provide job-embedded coaching for grades Kindergarten through Twelve.

Each of these contracts was developed through collaboration with district and building leaders to ensure that the service met their exact interests and needs.
